The candidate must score at least 70 points on the ANADOLUYÖS Turkish Test, or a valid B2-level score according to the European Language Portfolio (ADP) on the "Anadolu Turkish Language Proficiency Exam" conducted by Anadolu University Turkish Teaching Application and Research Center (ANADOLU TÖMER) or "Turkish Proficiency Exam (TYS)" conducted by Yunus Emre Institute.
