APPLICATION METHOD:

- 1- International applicants will submit their applications between **05 July - 30 July 2021** at basvuruyld.anadolu.edu.tr
- 2- In order for the candidates to apply, they must first sign up to the system only once using the "Register" link. Afterwards, the candidates will sign in with their Foreign Identity No/Passport No/Residence Permit No and they will be guided by the system and submit their applications.
- 3- Two different types of quota have been opened for each program, one for Turkish and one for Foreign Nationals. Therefore, candidates must choose the appropriate program in order to apply for the quota they want. For example, for the Primary Education Program, candidates must choose the Primary Education (Foreign National) section to apply for the international quota. Applications with incorrect type of nationality will be considered invalid.
- 4- All international applicants applying to graduate programs will upload 2 “Reference Letters” to the relevant section of the application program. Candidates who do not upload their reference letter will not be considered.
- 5- Each candidate will be able to apply to two different programs at the related Graduate School, provided that the final registration is completed for only one program. However, in Distance Education Non-Thesis Master's Programs, only one program can be applied for.
- 6- Candidates who misrepresent their information during the application will have their applications canceled even if they gain the right to register.
- 7- Application results will be announced in the announcements section of the related Graduate School's website. Candidates who are eligible to register will be accepted if they send the documents uploaded during the application to the relevant Graduate School address to prove the information they have declared during the application.
- 8- Applications will be evaluated by the relevant Graduate School Administrations.

APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

- 1- Evaluation in graduate program applications will be based on GPA (Except Fine Arts Graduate School Programs).
In order of success, "Grade Point Averages" will be evaluated out of 100. If the evaluation system in which the student is studying is 100, a score of 100 should be entered, and if it is 4, a grade of 4. The candidate who has a "Transcript" in both the 100 and quaternary systems has to enter his "GPA" in the quaternary (4.0) system. For the candidates whose "GPA" is calculated according to a different system, the equivalent of "GPA" out of 100 will be calculated by Anadolu University and according to the Senate Decision taken on the subject <https://www.anadolu.edu.tr/ogrenci-isleri/orgun-bilgi-ve-belgeler/senato-ve-yonetim-kurulu-kararlari/turk-ve-kibris-universiteleri-not-karsiliklari> ve <https://www.anadolu.edu.tr/ogrenci-isleri/orgun-bilgi-ve-belgeler/senato-ve-yonetim-kurulu-kararlari/yabanci-universiteler-not-karsiliklari>. The ranking of success in the evaluation will be made from the highest score to the lowest score. If the scores are equal in the ranking, priority will be given to the candidate with a high undergraduate diploma grade, and in case of equality here, the younger candidate will be given priority.
- 2- A minimum of 60 points must be obtained from the talent exam to be applied for Graduate School of Fine Arts graduate and proficiency in arts program applications. In the major art departments of the Graduate School of Fine Arts, exams are conducted in the form of portfolio review and/or artistic practices and interviews. Detailed information on the timing and format of practice exams can be obtained from the relevant major arts department. Graduate School of Fine Arts departments' success grade is calculated by taking 40% of the undergraduate average and 60% of the "Talent Exam" result. In order to be considered successful in the "Talent Exam", it is mandatory to get at least 60 points out of 100.
 - a) In order to be able to start PhD / Proficiency in Art programs and Master's programs taught in a foreign language, candidates are required to document their foreign language score. In order to start the Doctorate / Proficiency in Art Program, the candidates must have received at least 55 points on the foreign language exams organized by OSYM or an equivalent score on the international foreign language exams whose equivalence is accepted by OSYM.
 - b) In order to be able to start the programs that teach in a foreign language (other than foreign language education/linguistics programs), the candidates must have received at least 60 points from the foreign language exams organized by OSYM in the foreign language they will study or an equivalent score from the international foreign language exams accepted as equivalent by OSYM.
 - c) Candidates applying for a Master's or PhD in a foreign language education/linguistics fields must have obtained at least 80 points in the foreign language they will study, or an equivalent score in the international foreign language exams accepted as equivalent by OSYM.
- 3- Candidates who are accepted to the program but failed to achieve the required Foreign Language Proficiency will have to receive foreign language education at Anadolu University Continuing Education Center in accordance with the Principles of International Student Admission to Anadolu University Graduate Programs accepted by Anadolu University Senate.
- 4- Foreign candidates who are accepted to programs whose language of instruction is Turkish must certify that they have obtained a score at the Turkish Teaching Center (TÖMER) and European Language Portfolio (ADP) level equivalent (C1) in order to start the program, or they must get the required score on the Turkish Placement and Proficiency Exam held by Anadolu TÖMER. A student who scores 70 points or more on the "Placement Exam" takes the "Proficiency Exam". The Turkish language of the student who scores at least 70 points out of 100 points in the "Proficiency Exam" is considered sufficient for the graduate program he/she is applying for. Foreign nationals who have graduated from undergraduate programs in which the language of instruction is Turkish are considered sufficient. Candidates who are accepted to the program but cannot achieve Turkish language proficiency receive Turkish education at Anadolu TÖMER in accordance with the Principles of International Student Admission to Anadolu University Graduate Programs accepted by the Anadolu University Senate.

Documents to be Uploaded during the Application:

- a) For the candidates applying to a Master's program and post-undergraduate PhD/ proficiency in arts programs, the original of the undergraduate "Transcript" and its notarized Turkish translation translated by a sworn translator, for the candidates applying to the post-graduate PhD / proficiency in arts program, the original of the Master's "Transcript" and its notarized Turkish translation translated by a sworn translator
- b) For the applicants to a Master's program and post-undergraduate PhD / proficiency in arts program, the original of the undergraduate diploma or graduation certificate and its notarized Turkish translations translated by a sworn translator, and for those applying to the post-graduate PhD / proficiency in arts program, the original of the graduate diploma or graduation certificate, and its notarized Turkish translation translated by a sworn translator.
- c) Turkish Proficiency Certificate (if any) for applications to programs taught in Turkish
- d) Foreign language exam result document (if any) for applications to PhD/ Proficiency in Art programs and master's programs in foreign languages.
- e) 2 (two) Reference Letters written in Turkish or English
- f) Passport Photo
- g) Passport Photocopy

REGISTRATION:

Candidates whose applications are properly completed will be sent a Letter of Acceptance/Conditional Acceptance by the International Relations Office and they will be asked to register on the registration date. Candidates should follow the registration guidelines on the relevant graduate school web page. Registrations will be checked and approved by the Graduate School Registrar's Office. The approval process should be followed at “basvuruyld.anadolu.edu.tr”. The color copies of the documents and their notarized Turkish translations translated by a sworn translator must be submitted to the Graduate School Registrar’s Office by the end of the course add-drop week. Registrations without the necessary documents will be canceled.

Candidates with missing/false declarations of documents required for registration will not be registered. The registration of students who are found to have made false statements after registration will be cancelled.

Students who complete their registration to the program must choose the courses they will take between September 27-October 01, 2021, and have it approved by the registration advisor. Otherwise, they will be considered as not registered.
